In October Jeremy was at the Wildscreen International Wildlife and Environmental Film Festival which took place at the Watershed in Bristol.

Jeremy had a presence at the Films at 59 stand at the Trade Show. Every 2 years the Watershed

hosts a festival, trade show and series of seminars, aimed at the international wildlife filming community.

Jeremy made numerous contacts, some past, some present and some new. However the common theme was that training is very much at the front of peoples' minds and a number were very interested in our range of workshops, particularly the Company Bespoke Workshops.

Location Visits & Mentoring

One of the areas that Jeremy has been made aware, particularly with the Induction and Foundation workshops, is that a number of participants are yet to see a crew and team in action on location.

Filming Projects

Jeremy has recently returned from Toulouse having worked with Nigel Lawson for a global warming film, due for cinema release in the USA in the New Year. Additionally Jeremy has also been filming in the Scilly Isles with Martin Clunes for his new ITV series 'Islands of Britain'.

November sees Jeremy travelling to County Durham, filming for 5 weeks, the next 'Ladette to Lady' series, for ITV. This run has an additional twist in that not only is the series aimed for Australian TV, but consists of all Australian ladettes!



Before Christmas Jeremy will be shooting for the BBC's landmark 'Darwin' series, presented by Andrew Marr, and like the 'Islands of Britain' series, this is shot on HD.

Very excitingly early next year, Jeremy, as Director of Photography, is to be shooting a huge observational series for BBC TV in Africa.... more details to come in the January newsletter.
